


Norwich Pride is for everyone and we welcome people of all ages and abilities. Online we have a page providing access information at: norwichpride.org.uk/access

On the day you will find a helpdesk in Chapelfield Gardens with information on Shopmobility, quiet area, location of disabled toilets and other useful information. There is a disabled viewing area at the front of the stage to allow everybody to get involved in the live show. Access stewards will also be available to ensure that you can get around and find what you need as easily as possible.

The parade has a new route this year (see map, page 8) down Gaol Hill, along Bedford Street and London Street, before joining Gentleman's Walk and Theatre Street - finally arriving at Chapelfield Gardens, ready to enjoy the amazing Pride Show!


