**55%** of LGBT+ pupils experience homophobic bullying.

**32%** of gay pupils experiencing bullying change their future education plans because of it & for **60%** their school work is impacted.

Gay people who are bullied are at a higher risk of suicide, self-harm & depression. For young trans people, the statistics are even worse.

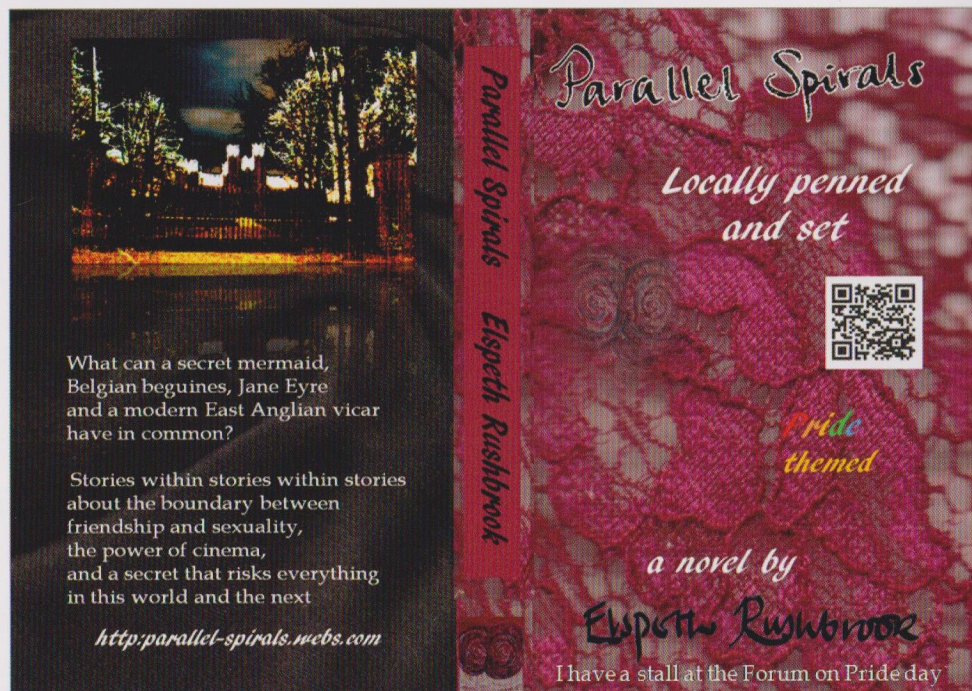

Created by David Shenton in 1992, The Duvet of Love is a full size duvet cover pinned with thousands of button badges that make up a mosaic.

Included are historic LGBT badges from the 1970s and 80s & badges of local relevance.

In 2016 the Duvet was donated to Norfolk Museums Service, along with other items from David's collection. The Museum sees this as an important step in developing its LGBT+ collections.



Norfolk LGBT+ Project is a community based charity, comprising nine groups, providing support for the health, wellbeing & needs of the LGBT+ community in Norfolk & Waveney.

New services include support for victims & survivors of domestic abuse, sexual violence & for parents of LGBT+ individuals.

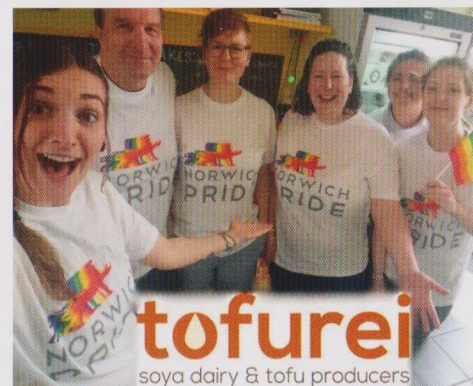
Addressing homophobic & transphobic bullying in schools is a top priority – **Think B4U Bully** is a hard hitting workshop highlighting the consequences.

Our events enable older gay men to meet in real time, rather than online.

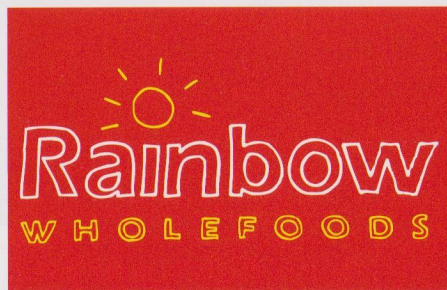
**We meet once a month at Lollards Pit for drinks & have an LGBT+ film night at the Catherine Wheel.**

In 1977 Gilbert Baker created a positive gay symbol for the community.

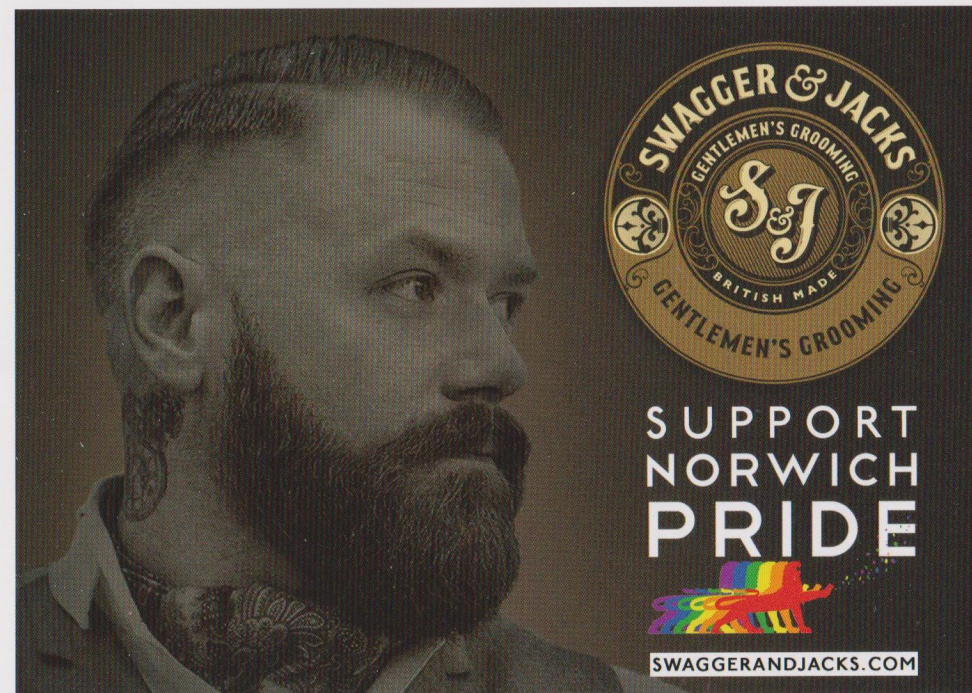
Gilbert dyed fabrics & stitched together eight strips to form a huge banner. Pink for sexuality, red for life, orange for healing, yellow for the sun, green for nature, turquoise for art, indigo for harmony, and violet for spirit.

San Francisco saw the first 'Rainbow Flags' flown in 1978 on Gay Freedom Day. Baker asked Paramount Flag Company to mass produce them, but fuchsia wasn't available, and indigo was later removed to make today's six colour flag.

The world saw the longest Rainbow Flag, 1.25 miles, in Key West in 2003.

Gilbert died aged 65 in March this year, but his symbol of Pride will live on forever. We love ya Gilbert!

In October 2013 Proud Canaries were the first LGBTQ fan group in the country to be given official recognition by a club, building on NCFC's long record of active opposition to discrimination, and reverence for Justin Fashanu— still the only Out elite male footballer.

Proud Canaries attend London, Manchester and Norwich Pride. Last year, for the first time, the club showed support by flying the Rainbow Flag at Carrow Road.

Proud Canaries were invited recently to appear at Westminster and give evidence to the Select Committee on Homophobia in Sport.

## Our journey

Fifty years ago, being gay in Britain was illegal and could lead to prosecution & imprisonment.

Alan Turing (pictured) was convicted in 1952 and took his own life in 1954. On the 27th July 1967 the first tentative steps were taken to decriminalise homosexuality, although this was only the case if you were 'over 21 behind locked doors and windows and with no other person present on the premises'.

This disparity between gay and straight law meant that between 1967 & 2003 over 30,000 gay & bisexual men were convicted for behaviour that would have been legal with women.

The age of consent was reduced to 18 in 1994 but an equal age of consent (16) would not be introduced until 34 years after the bill, in 2001. In 2005 Civil Partnerships were introduced & same sex marriage followed in 2014. Perhaps in another 50 years we'll just be calling it marriage.

In January 2017 thousands of men convicted of offenses that once criminalised homosexuality but are no longer on the statute book have been posthumously pardoned under a new law.

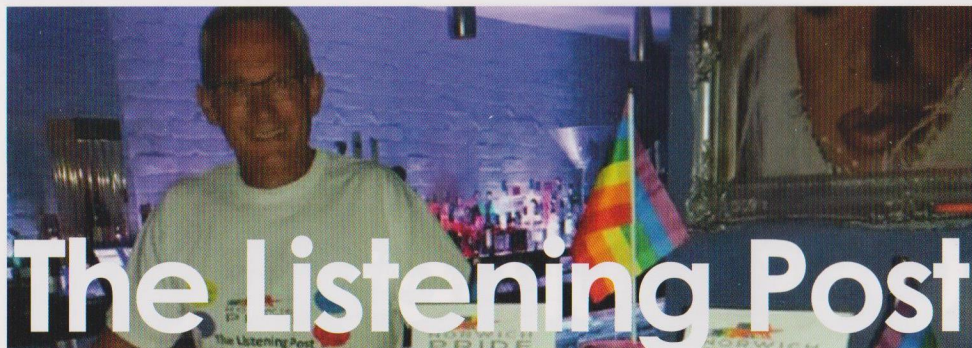

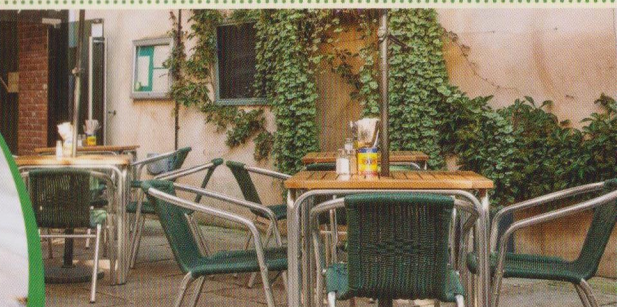
